# Susie's Background

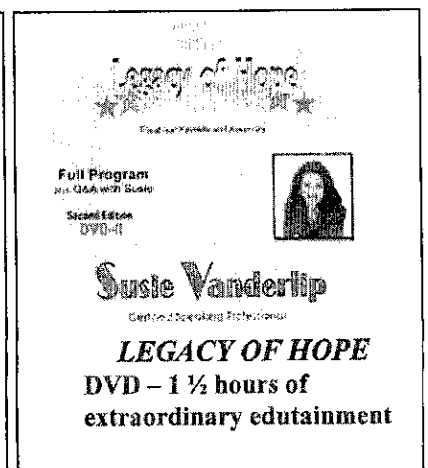
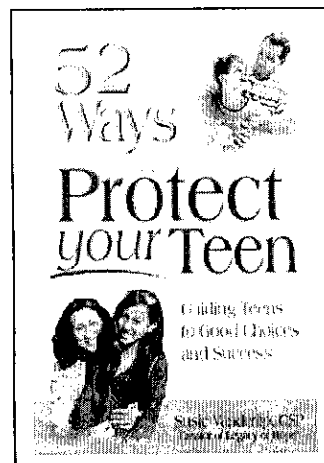
